2024/2025 Scholarships by Private Foundations, etc. Registration application notice (1st semester of 2024)

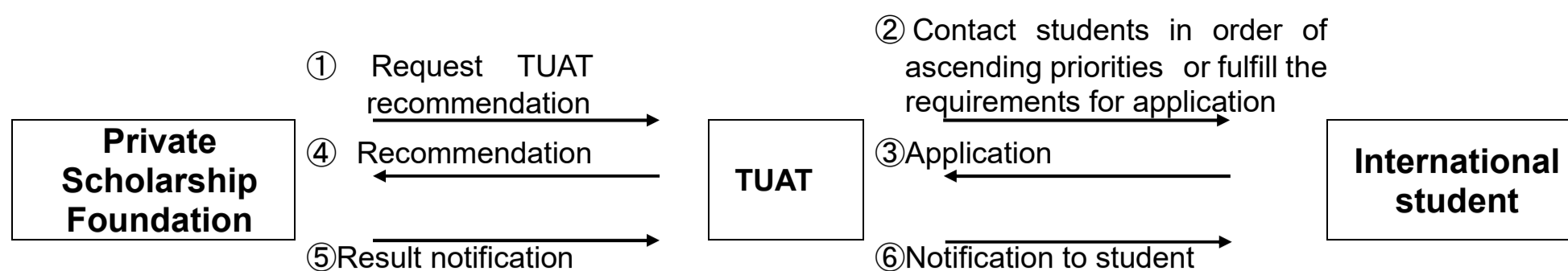
Application Period: Apr. 3, 2024 (WED) ~ Apr. 19, 2024 (FRI)

- ★ Privately financed international students who wish to receive university recommendation scholarships in 2024 and 2025 should apply for registration within the above period. (Including Research Students)
 - ★ Most of these foundations require scholarship recipients to have a “Student” visa status.
 - ★ If you would like to apply to these scholarships, we recommend that you register with TUAT twice a year, in April and October.
 - ★ Please submit the following documents to your faculty/graduate school office.
 - * Registration form
 - * Other required documents (Please contact your faculty/graduate school office.)
- ※ Applicants must meet a certain level of Japanese or English language proficiency.

★ Method of recommendation

After students submit the documents, TUAT decides the order of recommendation priority by document screening and/or interviews. Then, when a request from a private foundation arrives at TUAT, we will inform the students in order of ascending priorities through the faculty/graduate school office. Students who receive the information can decide whether to apply for the scholarship. After confirming the student's intention to apply, TUAT sends a recommendation to the private foundation.

- A separate interview or document screening may be requested by the foundation.
- You can not decline your recommendation.
- Scholarship recipients are required to participate in the foundation's exchange meeting(s)/project(s).
- Students will be informed of the result from TUAT, after TUAT receives the result from the foundation.
- TUAT will issue a recommendation for “Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately-Financed International Students” only when additional hiring is requested.



★ Notice

- ① We can NOT assure that you will receive a scholarship even if you are registered with TUAT and have a recommendation from TUAT.
- ② You can not receive scholarships from two foundations in the same year.
- ③ You may contact your faculty/graduate school office for information on TUAT's order of recommendation priority.
- ④ Only Privately Financed International Students (including Research Students) who are enrolled in TUAT as of April 1, 2024 can register.
- ⑤ There are other kinds of scholarships which you do not require recommendation from TUAT. You can apply directly to these scholarships. Please visit each private foundation's website and check the details.

★ Registration and screening schedule

Apr. 3 ~ Apr. 19

Please submit the documents to your faculty/graduate school office if you would like to receive a scholarship from a private foundation, etc..

Mid-May Screening at each faculty/graduate school

End of May TUAT decides the order of recommendation priority from the result of the screening.

TUAT recommends candidates to private foundations in order of ascending priorities concerning requirements for application.
